## I MUST SLEEP, PLEASE!

SUSANNE KUTTER

Il nuovo lavoro di Susanne Kutter, pensato e realizzato appositamente per lo spazio milanese della galleria, si svolge come un'unica installazione intorno al tema della precarietà della visione. Cosa ci spinge fin da piccoli a separare noi e il mondo? Con quali meccanismi percettivi distinguiamo l'altro da sé? E infine, come e in che termini possiamo sottrarci a questa legge naturale e pensare di mimetizzarci fino a far quasi sparire le tracce della nostra presenza? Nell'età adulta la creatività artistica è uno dei momenti in cui soggetto e oggetto appaiono fusi insieme. Ma è anche nella precarietà del vivere che ci circonda che l'artista ritrova quel filo originario. Le strutture precarie dei senza tetto, le tende e i rifugi da loro costruiti per ripararsi, il loro vedere senza essere visti, tutto ciò permette all'artista tedesca di elaborare un percorso che in questa mostra dall'installazione si snoda attraverso la fotografia e l'assemblage. Il lavoro della Kutter mostra anche in questo caso una forma di resistenza alla vetrinizzazione, andando oltre l'apparenza della presentazione, destabilizzando le aspettative e aprendo a fertili inquietudini interpretative che coinvolgono lo spettatore.

Partendo dall'ambivalenza delle convenzioni del vedere l'arte di Susanne Kutter si fa segno della differenza, analizzando anche, con ammiccante malizia e tagliente ironia, concetti architettonici e soluzioni spaziali identificate come dispositivi di controllo o veicoli di autoritarismo.

Attraverso questo lavoro l'artista mette in questione i codici di comportamento individuali e collettivi, tra intimità psicologiche, processi di distorsione dei media ed eccentricità interpretative.

## I MUST SLEEP, PLEASE!

SUSANNE KUTTER

Susanne Kutter's new work, specially devised and created for the gallery's Milan branch, evolves as a single installation around the theme of the precariousness of vision. What drives us as children to separate ourselves from the world? With what perceptive mechanisms do we distinguish the other from ourselves? And finally, how and under what circumstances can we circumvent this natural law and attempt to camouflage ourselves to the point where the traces of our presence virtually disappear?

In adulthood artistic creativity is one of these moments, in which the interplay between subject and object appears to be fused and cohesive. But it is also in the precariousness of life around us that the artist finds that primordial thread. The precarious circumstances of the homeless, the shelters they build to take refuge in, their seeing without being seen and their human condition – these allow the German artist to trace out a path from her installation that involves photography and assemblage. Here too, Kutter's work shows a form of resistance to spectacularising or showcasing our lives, going beyond the appearance presented, subverting expectations and prompting fertile interpretative concerns that involve the observer.

Susanne Kutter's art unveils the ambivalence of seeing and its conventions, and it does so by eluding these mechanisms; at the same time, with playful mischief and cutting irony, it reveals the true nature of architectural concepts and spatial solutions, making us realise that they are vehicles of authoritarianism or devices of control.

Through this work, the artist questions individual and collective codes of behaviour, encompassing psychological intimacy, processes of media distortion and interpretative eccentricities.

## LOST IN THE MIDDLE OF THE STREET

SUSANNE KUTTER

Susanne Kutter, nata a Wernigerode in Germania nel 1971 ma oggi residente a Berlino, presenta una serie di nuovi lavori concepiti appositamente per lo spazio della galleria. Il lavoro video e installativo di Susanne Kutter da sempre ruota intorno ai meccanismi che creano e sedimentano in ognuno di noi certezze e aspettative, per poi eluderle e frustrarle attraverso piccole e grandi catastrofi quotidiane. Smontando e relativizzando i preconcetti, il lavoro dell'artista tedesca mostra anche che quanto ciò che pensiamo di vedere è spesso illusorio e irreale, frutto più della nostra educazione o delle nostre paure, che realmente corrispondente alla realtà delle cose.

Se spesso il suo lavoro si è concentrato sull'ambiente domestico, costruendo modelli in scala reale che poi finiscono per essere sovertiti o finiscono completamente distrutti, come nel video *Die Zuckerdose* [La Zuccheriera], l'installazione realizzata per MAAB Gallery ci trasporta in un anonimo parcheggio sotterraneo la cui visione lascia però spazio a diverse perplessità percettive e alla materializzazione di estranianti presenze che sta all'osservatore individuare e che si ripresentano anche nei light-boxes che accompagnano questo lavoro.

Smuovere e sovertire uno stato di quiete ordinata e sfidare le leggi della logica sembrano così essere temi ricorrenti del lavoro di Susanne Kutter, come avviene puntualmente nelle altre opere in mostra: un'intera parete di ripiani su cui vasi e ceramiche pericolosamente sfidano le leggi della fisica, oltre che la nostra incolumità, e una serie di quadri incidentati dove vetri rotti e cocci raccontano di passati disastri e di nuove configurazioni plastico-pittoriche.

La mostra è accompagnata da un catalogo con testo critico di Gianluca Ranzi.

## LOST IN THE MIDDLE OF THE STREET

SUSANNE KUTTER

Susanne Kutter, born in Wernigerode, Germany, in 1971 but who today lives in Berlin, is presenting a series of new works specifically conceived for the rooms of the gallery. Susanne Kutter's video and installation work has always been centred on the mechanisms that create and deposit certainties and expectations in each of us, only then to elude them and frustrate them through small and large everyday catastrophes. By dismantling and reconsidering preconceptions, the work of this German artist also shows just how much of what we think we see is often illusory and unreal, the result of our education or fears more than being a reflection of the reality of things.

If her work is often concentrated on the domestic setting, with the construction of life-size models that then end up being undermined or completely destroyed, such as in the video *Die Zuckerdose [The sugar bowl]*, the installation created for the MAAB Gallery transports us into an anonymous underground car park. A view of it, however, leaves space for various perceptive perplexities and for the materialisation of alienating presences that it is up to the viewer to pinpoint and that are also represented in the light-boxes that accompany this work.

So the recurrent themes in Susanne Kutter's work seem to be to shake and subvert a state of ordered calm and to challenge the laws of logic. This happens too in the other works in the show: a whole wall of shelves on which vases and ceramics dangerously threaten the laws of physics, besides our own safety and a series of damaged paintings where broken glass and shards tell of a devastated past and of new sculptural-pictorial configurations.

The show has a catalogue with a critical essay by Gianluca Ranzi.




